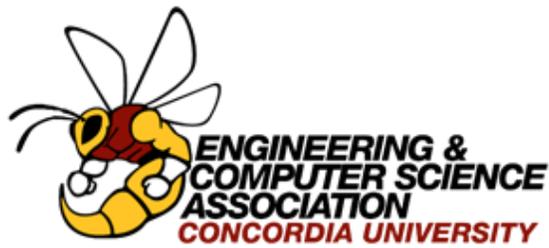



4. EXTERNAL PRESENTATIONS

4.1. Interviewing & Selection of the Vice-President of Social Affairs and Vice-President of Marketing

4.1.1. Chloe Law (for VP Social)

Interview began at 6:24 PM

Chloe: I'm a first year Software Engineering student. I went to a few Frosh events online; mostly with EngGames. Some people that see me from the EngGames know me. I stay stuff out of my head, I don't care what people think about me, I'm having fun. If you're not having fun with me, then your loss. I don't care about ridiculizing myself. I've worked at a summer camp for five years. It made me into a super fun person; regardless of what people think of me. I love planning events. School is boring enough. If I'm able to create something extravagant online, then I want to do that. I want to make things funner than what we can do in person. It'd be nice to include more people. Last year was difficult to integrate myself as a first year. What helped me the most are events that people planned. Since I know what it's like to find people as a first year, I have personal feelings towards meeting and seeking people who are more shy. I'm an extrovert. I don't care about being new and not knowing much: I'm willing to learn, ask for help, and not afraid to fail. Why I want to be VP Social is because I want to party, go crazy, and have fun. I understand there are serious aspects too. I want to bring my own youthness, fun to things around us. I love working in teams because it brings everyone's personality together. I may not be good at- say, Finance, I won't be able to handle



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that. Me and numbers are not a good mix. Since I'm an explosive person, I can bring in weird ideas that people may not think of.

Kayla: I can see you having a fun time in this role. How much time are you willing to devote?

Chloe: I'm willing to give in as many hours as I need during the week. If you tell me to spend a whole day in one shot, that, I won't be able to do. You are students and are able to separate things evenly, and that's how I need to roll too. If everyone can do their part properly, then I can input my part properly. I work depending on how much other people work. If i see one person work 1 hour a day, then i can if not, more. If i'm here, i'm willing to go all the way, and give it my all; while also valuing school. I'm willing to put as much sacrifice as you guys are to be part of this team.

Kayla: Are you in Co-op? Are you going to be enrolled in either Co-op or in a class in the Fall and Winter semester?

Chloe: I'm in Co-op looking for an internship in the fall. I'm enrolled in summer, and I'm enrolled in winter. I don't plan on taking a semester off.

Kayla: You mentioned EngGames and Frosh. Is there any other ECA event or association you attended?

Chloe: I participated in an entrepreneurship competition. I entered a competition and won fourth place. We couldn't win third place because we weren't able to do things properly. It was super fun; I've never done this before but thank god I had third years mentoring me.

Kayla: 1) If online frosh: what's your vision. 2) In-person frosh: what's your vision?

Chloe: 1) You're in a team for one day, and then you scramble. Froshees can go booth to booth. We can do Among Us, or Sketch.IO. It's hard to meet on a personal level; which is what is lacking online. Make smaller intimate groups, and gradually expand. 2) I've never attended an in-person frosh, but it should be crazy. To have people do team bonding, challenges, meet from other programs.

Kayla: That's the end of questions, on my part. Does the BOD have any other questions?

David: Can you tell us your experience on organizing events?

Chloe: Majority of my experience comes from camp with kids. Obviously kids and adults are not the same thing. One of my greatest skill: with kids is that I can create something with any group age and any character. I like to take people's



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input and make something fresh, new, and fun. I know you guys play Among Us, Variations, and that's the type of spin on events. I can take my own spin on things. I'm very flexible to any outcome that's happening.

Kayla: Do you have any questions for us?

Chloe: What are your expectations for someone in this position?

Kayla: They organize Frosh, Halloween, Lizard Lounges, Winter Frosh: have those be as lit as possible. That's the role of VP social. Dealing with COVID restrictions. Take into account conservative and non-conservative aspects. I'm not opposed to giving you help. Teammates, Directors, and Frosh Committee

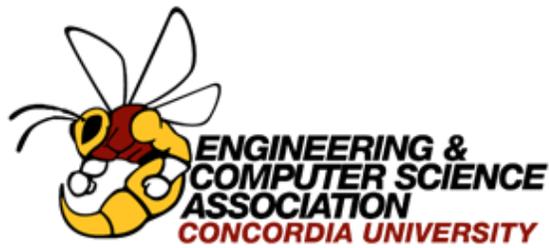
Chloe: As a person, I'm very direct. I won't be afraid to voice out. That's something you guys have to "deal with".

Interview began at 6:44 PM

Bryan: I already have my schedule made.

Kayla: What events/associations have you been most involved in/most marked you?

Bryan: Ironically, I haven't been to any big Concordia events because I started in Winter 2020. But I snuck into McGill Frosh and had a great time. Also Power Hours. I've done smaller events through COVID; like la course for EngGames.

4.1.3. Isabelle Crepeau (VP Social)

A recorded interview:

Isabelle: I'm a Civil Engineering student going into my 3rd year starting Fall 2021. Other than applying for the ECA, I'm involved in the GNCTR competition for this coming school year. I also take part in entrepreneurship competitions. I'm trying to get into the EngGames delegation. Outside of university, I'm working part time with an internship lined up.



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Kayla: Your internship is when?

Isabelle: June until September.

Kayla: Just checking. There are rules about being enrolled in school where you have to have at least a class for the Fall and Winter. How many hours can you devote to this position per week?

Isabelle: Maximum 20 hours. It's a lot, but for certain events it's necessary to put in more hours. With my schedule, I can do 15-20 hours I'd be willing to put in.

Kayla: As you know, one of the biggest parts of your job is to organize Frosh. If it's mostly online, what do you see as your vision for an online Frosh?

Isabelle: For online: Zoom breakout rooms in a speed dating sense. Maybe integrate some mini games in there. Host trivia nights, game nights. Online treasure hunts I'd like to organize. I haven't thought of anything else, but I'd have to ask around (make polls) and do some research.

Kayla: There's the regular Frosh and then the toned down version. Do you have an idea on how you'd approach that?

Isabelle: The easiest way to have multiple people is to have it in parts. Frosh leaders have their own groups within regulations from the government. Have them at a park and fraternize. I don't know if people would play sports outside... it's the whole question of, "are people comfortable with it." There was a treasure hunt last year which was nice: could be an option. Outdoors activities are a good way to go.

Kayla: Are you open and interested in having help?


Isabelle: Yes. Having different perspectives is good but most importantly you should make a decision.

Akshit: I cannot speak nor write in French. I only know a few words.


Kayla: Do you have any questions for us?

Kayla: For Marketing: Any experience on software for marketing?


Sabrina: I've used Canva a bit but I have a sister who knows a lot.

Elsa: Yes. More than english.


Kayla: Do you have any questions for us?





6.1. Disclosure of Relationship of the President and VP Finance

Kayla: As you all may or may not know, Remi and I are in a relationship. We want to disclose it to BOD, and have it in the public minutes to be transparent, and let everyone in our membership know that we are a thing. Does anyone have any questions?

6.2. Office Manager

Kayla: We want to hire Sharon as an office manager. We started the interview process before the transition: Kim, David, and I did the interview process. We felt we should not sign in on any new personnel at the end of the year hence why we're doing it now. I just wanted to bring it to BOD to approve the salary and disclose that it's: Remi's father's ex wife who is qualified. She's been an office manager for some kind of Consulate before. She has a background in accounting. Familiar with the accounting software our accountant wants to transition to. Anybody have any questions about that?

David: To disclose: I called a reference of hers at a place she volunteered at and it was all positive. She's far better than any volunteer they had; very good with helping in accounting.

Kayla: We did a background check too and it's clean.



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Ariane: What's the salary we're gonna give her?

Kayla: She asked for 40k a year in the interview. We gave her just a little more. 21.40\$/hour

Remi: To Ariane about salary: I want to mention how the hiring is gonna happen. Until August she would work part time or however much work we'd give. Starting at that August date, she'd then become a full time 40-hour/week employee.

Kayla: This contract is 1 year, till next June. So next year's team can get help from her in the transition and then decide to sign her again for a long term basis if they liked her.

Mason: I want to know: what's her role in the team?

Kayla: Main role of previous Office Manager: they sit in office, takes reimbursement forms, has cheques, takes payments. We want to dynamically grow her role as she goes on: help with bookings, help communication in the departments, triple checking the accounting, help with auditing, selling the merch that we have in the ECA office, documentation, if she has the skills: maybe deal with the website. She acts as the institutional resource of the ECA so next year, she can help the execs with transition time.

Ariane: I believe also, at any point an exec can't fulfill their mandate, she's gonna be the one to help do that. For example: if someone has an operation, she can help so the rest of the BOD won't "melt".

6.3. CSU Councillors Vote at ECA Council

David: Important part of Council is to have various opinions and democratic votes. Lacking in ECA Council: opinion of Council members in the CSU council. Having those representatives of Engineering students have a voice in ECA council will have more connection between ECA and CSU. It would help to create an alternative use. Only MA can vote right now. We'll have additional votes which can create a better democratic environment.



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Kayla: Question: The reason we're doing this is to create a link between CSU and ECA? I have trouble having the value of them voting. What's the point. CSU and ECA are supposed to be distinct bodies. I know you're a rep of engineering students but isn't that what an independent rep is for?

Ariane: Kayla, I see your point. But as an Independent rep, they don't have a right of vote in council. Having the right of vote in BOD and Council is important. Having people vote by the students in Council and can vote as well as Council for ECA: could be great. It might not be a permanent solution. Maybe we can try for one year?

Mason: For clarification: a lot of our participating organizations go to the CSU for funding. If we collaborate with them would create a lot of conflict in interest in that sense

Ariane: There is no collaboration. It's more like someone can ask you to do things like a society does. It's just that people represent the student body that can ask you things for the student body.

David: These people get voted in much like how a VP for ECA. But CSU holds it. They can voice opinions of engineering students that can be brought up in Council and CSU level. Having them attend our meetings help facilitate that process.

Kayla: I see the value of CSU of attending the meetings. But do they need the right to vote? Long term, is it better to have the - so that it's separate from the CSU, have them elected in at our elections?


Ariane: Not giving right of vote is not giving students at large right of vote in Council. Long term: there's no right solution the first time

Davd: Since they are students and are voted in, they don't have the right of vote in BOD meetings, but in Council, it's an adversarial body that gives advice for BOD. I think it's fine. Because they don't have BOD power; it's just advice. According to Bylaw: Recommendation to the council to make. It gives outside opinions within the current voting members to be voiced that could also potentially affect the BOD in the future. Non voting members can be a general CSU (independent viewer), but they wouldn't be related to engineering. Elected ones can provide value.

Kayla: To clarify: do you suggest a bylaw for it?

David: Yeah

Kayla: This year, we'd motion that CSU counselors have the right to vote for this year's purpose and have it voted as a bylaw at the referendum.



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David: Bringing in bylaw is brought to referendum to have official vote. We'd need bylaw change because composition of council is defined within the bylaw.

Kayla: I'm motioning this because I want to read the Bylaws properly before the next meeting to avoid wasting time.

David: I know that you want to change the bylaw right now. It might be ideal but we should wait for the next BOD so you can word it out. The process for a Bylaw change: is to have an open doc with the amendment. Propose to chair, and chair will present it. We can motion to do this in the future rather than changing bylaw directly.
