

Frosh Committee

- Frosh is one of the largest attended events organized by ECA. It demands an abundance of time and preparation to execute properly and create a memorable experience for new students.
- It occurs at the beginning of the newly elected ECA executive team's mandate. Therefore, they simultaneously have a plethora of organizational matters to deal with.
- Outside parties such as member associations and undergraduate students should be involved in the planning and execution phases.

Proposition

- Creation of a Frosh Committee
- Composition: minimum 8 members, maximum 14 members
 - *Mandatory* 4 ECA Executives
 - *Mandatory* 4 appointed students
 - *Facultative* rest of the ECA executives
 - *Facultative* 2 "Sages" - previous ECA executives

Details

- 4 appointed members
 - Letter of intent to be sent to President and VP Social, the letter of intent can be in the form of an entry to a google form expressing interest in being interviewed.
 - Candidate will be filtered by the letter
 - Selected candidates will be interviewed in front of the Board of Directors
 - Selection will be done by the BOD before the end of June.
- Power and Responsibilities
 - Decisions: all notable/high-level decisions with regards to Frosh will be approved by the Board of Directors - e.g. they will be discussed in the committee then presented to BOD for final approval
 - This includes, but is not limited to:
 - Schedule
 - Money
 - Bookings
 - Concerns pertaining to the security and life of students
 - Any unresolved conflicts/decision in the Committee
 - Core actions are also taken by Committee
 - This includes, but is not limited to:
 - Logistic of each event (e.g. the plan of the BBQ, getting electrical outlets, figure out bus schedules, getting permits, if online: meeting with companies to plan large group events)
 - Recruit volunteers
 - Organize harm reduction training
