## 4. EXTERNAL PRESENTATIONS

## 4.1. Interview of Aditya

Elsa: Hello, you applied for VP competitions so why don't you tell us more about yourself and why you think you're a good fit for this position.

## 5.1. ECA Chalet Budget

Shanon:So I wanted to motion to pass the Chalet budget. So for 50 people for 2 nights August 4th to August 6th it would be \$45 per person per night equaling a total of \$4500 and then for renting a common room for the weekend it would be \$1000 so including taxes it would be \$6500. And ECA is providing food so at first we provide Domino's pizzas and it would be the first meal provided in the Chalet. So 2 slices per person and a total of 14 pizzas with tax+ drinks and tip I think it would be \$250. I would also start asking for carpooling after the budget is approved but let's say we don't get enough people for carpooling we would get a bus \$510 and gratuity let's say \$100 the grand total would be \$610.

Jainam: So can I know what the Chalet is about?

Elsa: So it's just for the society's members, presidents and we train them there, do team bonding and get to know each other there.

Sierra: What is the venue for the first option?

Shannon: Oh it's Pourky. It's the place that CSU normally rents for their Chalet. It's not technically a Chalet, it's more like a camp with multiple Chalet. So people won't stay in the same Chalet but it's right beside each other and it varies the amount of people that can fit in one Chalet.

Sierra: I don't think we paid \$55/person last year.

Mohamed: Yeah so I did notice that the budget did not have food or bus and I think these are things we need to keep in mind. I think my main issue is with the common room because I saw Tharushi's comment like workshops in the common room but workshops

happen every year so why did we not pay for a common room last year but we are paying for it this year.

Sierra: So last year we paid a flat rate per person per night and they included that common room we had and they included per person per night so there wasn't a separate charge.

Shannon: So like I said it's not like one big chalet or one big room so it would technically be renting another room just to have a common area for people since it's not like one place you need to rent like another place just for the common room.

Mohamed: So my question is if option 2 last year's Chalet cost \$5000 and includes a common area, why are we considering the other option?

Shannon: So basically it wasn't available

Mohamed: So option 2 is basically not an option...

Shannon: Yeah basically I started looking about a month ago and people already booked the weekends that people are available for. And the other Chalets that were available were too expensive so I didn't even consider them.

Mohamed: Okay so I don't have any other questions. I was under the impression that we had another option but since that's not an option I'm good.

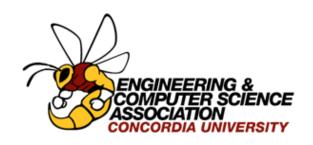
